The relationships that we form with students, families and each other is our biggest asset. In addition, we have a vibrant Outdoor Education program and utilize our school forest, gardens and orchards to connect our curriculum to the natural world around us. Progress

Our students made impressive gains in reading, math and social emotional learning. In fact, we outscored the district average by at least 10 percentage points in 8 out of 9 sub-groups as measured by MAP. Our focus on rigor, relationships and relevance is making a strong impact on our students.

Area for Growth

We will be strengthening our phonics instruction for our K-1 grades and focusing on small group instruction for all grade levels so that we can provide the necessary scaffolds to ensure all students have access to complex text. We will be providing project-based learning opportunities for our students to demonstrate their learning in a variety of ways.

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. 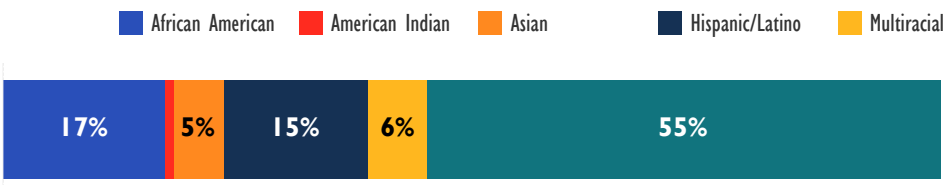

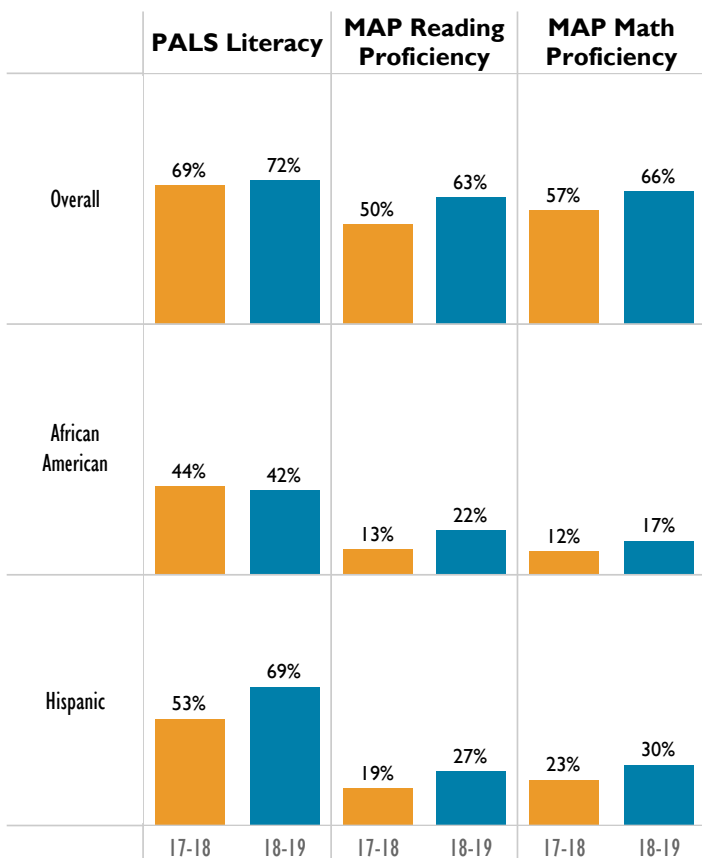
